Visa Requirements

- At least 6-month validity passport (clearly scanned)
- Insurance covering period of stay
- Last 6-month bank statement with minimum USD 2000 or equivalent balance
- Flight ticket reservation
- Hotel booking reservation
- Vaccine QR certificate
- 1 PP size photo with clear white background
- Relation certificate scanned
